Summer is here, and what better way to kick off it than by sipping a cocktail on one of NY's hottest rooftops? Inspired by a bygone era, the palatial and refined SPYGLASS rooftop bar features some of the most exquisite, breathtaking view of the Empire State building from every seat in the house. Guests can enjoy small bites from their creative menu such as the Candied Bacon (\$15; served with pickled vegetables), mixed with a rich maple syrup savory breakfast taste with a black pepper element that combines to create a smoky heat flavor, a dynamic combo. Among all their specialty cocktails, the Raspberry Caipirinha (avua cachaca, lime, raspberry, simple syrup \$15), a sweet-faced sip, may become a favorite among city girls. A cross between a fruity mojito and sangria, this honeyed cocktail, with hints of berries and tart lime, is saccharine enough to make your lips pucker. Bartender-friendly, this sophisticated rooftop is an ace place to unwind with a group of friends. – *Megan Greene*
