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## Global Cocktail: Spyglass Rooftop's The Empire State



Nothing says New York City summer quite like a rooftop bar. OK, maybe a New York City rooftop at one of the city's hottest new hotels, a view of the Empire State Building, and a deliciously sweet cocktail in hand. Located on yr 22<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Archer Hotel (47 West 38th St. between 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.), Spyglass Rooftop mixes a dose of 40s and 50s glamor with modern design elements, but who's really looking when you have a view that rivals many in Midtown. One of our favorite cocktails here, the Empire State, was created by expert-mixologist Joe Goglia who knows how to hit all the right notes for a Summer night.

### Directions

In a mixing glass, combine all ingredients. Shake, strain, and pour into a highball glass with ice. And finally, garnish with a basil leaf.
